The mission of InterIm Community Development Association (ICDA) is to advance social justice and equity for low income, Asian and Pacific Islander, immigrant, and refugee communities. ICDA provides holistic community development fundamentally grounded in our community's history, relationships, people and culture.

## PILLARS OF HOPE, ROOTS OF JUSTICE

### HUMAN SERVICES

**(Homelessness - Domestic Violence - Tenancy)**

In 2025, InterImCDA provided 930 families with culturally relevant direct services that prioritize getting and keeping families housed. InterIm CDA staff speak over 15 languages and represent 25 ethnicities, meeting the needs of families whose needs aren't met by mainstream services.

### AFFORDABLE HOUSING

We have developed and own over 500 units of low-income housing in the CID and South Seattle. We continue to develop new housing as the foundation of community development to preserve the historic fabric of the CID and address displacement.

### EQUITABLE DEVELOPMENT POLICY ADVOCACY & COMMUNITY ORGANIZING

We empower and amplify the voices of vulnerable community members, especially limited English-speaking immigrants and refugees, elders, and youth, building their engagement with and power in the systems that disproportionately impact them.

### DANNY WOO COMMUNITY GARDEN

The largest public green space in the CID including 100 garden plots tended to by elderly low-income immigrants and refugees, 63 fruit trees, chicken coop, and an outdoor kitchen. Foundation for environmental justice youth programs, education, and advocacy.

### THE WILDERNESS INNER-CITY LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (WILD)

An internship program for low-income immigrant and refugee youth 16+ to develop skills, connections, and confidence while serving their community.
